Enrolments

Enrolments are confirmed by payment of course fees via EFTPOS, credit card, cash or direct debit.

- Fees are to be **paid in full** prior to commencement of the course
- If a course is cancelled by the House, a full refund will be provided
- Refunds will not be provided **once your place has been confirmed** and the course is confirmed to commence by the House

Learn Local are not for profit community organisations registered and funded by the Adult Community and Further Education Board (ACFE) on behalf of the Victorian Government.

Learn Local courses enable you to develop your skills in a wide range of areas, opening up employment and further education possibilities such as TAFE (or university) qualification and helping you better connect with your community.

Eligibility criteria

Learn Local courses are available to a broad range of Victorians who are above compulsory school age and who are seeking to gain the educational capacity and core skills they need for further study, work, volunteering and life.

To be eligible to enrol in pre-accredited training participants must meet the following conditions:

- 17 and over and not enrolled at school or under 17 and not enrolled at school with exemption.
- Either an Australian citizen, a holder of an Australian Permanent Visa, a New Zealand citizen, or an Asylum Seeker holding a valid Visa that confers eligibility for Skills First Training under the the [Asylum Seeker VET program](#)
